



Painting instructions for
4085 Rock Cross

Kimble Colors needed: 750 Bisque Primer, 719 Ebony, 760 Antique Media, 713 Primrose, 714 Teal, 709 Topaz, 702 Walnut, 707 Evergreen, 761 Perfect Matte Spray, 902 Black.

Kimble IT Brushes, soft paper towel,

Use a large soft brush, to thoroughly basecoat the entire piece with 750 Bisque Primer. After basecoat is dry, use a large stiff brush to apply 719 Ebony to small areas of the cross at a time. Wipe back the area with a soft paper towel and proceed until the entire cross has been antiqued with the Ebony. Use

a soft paper towel moistened with 760 Antique Media to pat back the Ebony on the raised areas of the rocks. Tip a natural hair filbert brush (Kimble It Brush) in 713 Primrose and add a bit of color to random areas of select rocks. Pat the color back with a clean brush. Use the same technique to add 714 Teal and 709 Topaz independently to random areas of select rocks. In some areas, blend colors together to create new colors. You may need to reapply 719 Ebony to some areas of rocks to achieve desired effect as photographed. Pat back raised areas of some rocks with a soft paper towel moistened with 760 Antique Media. Use a small natural hair filbert brush to apply 702 Walnut to the twig border of the cross. Pat the Walnut back randomly with a soft paper towel. Use a small natural hair filbert to apply 707 Evergreen to the leaves and smooth back with brush. Allow the product to dry completely and spray with 761 Perfect Matte Spray. After the spray is dry, apply 902 Black to the lettering of the cross.
